

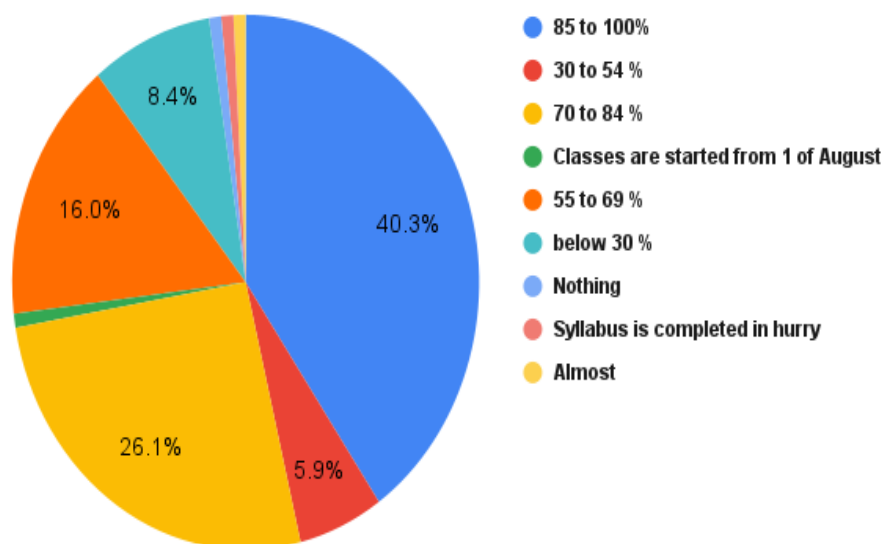
Report of Feedback Analysis 2022-23

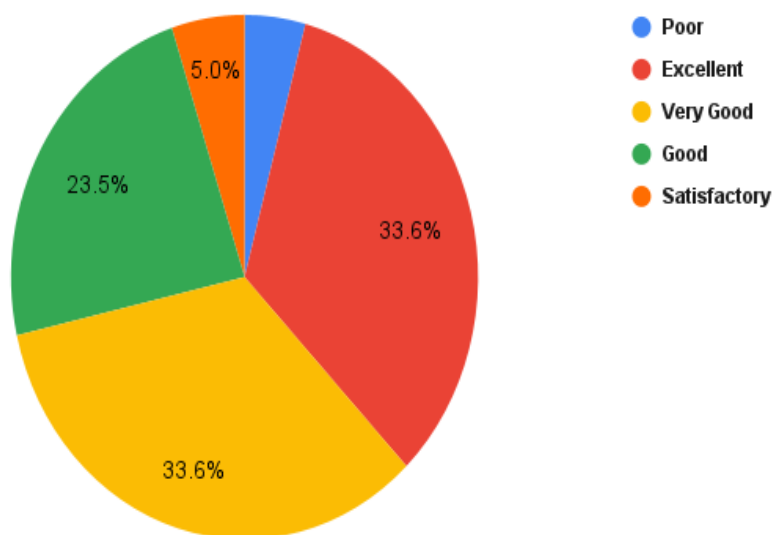
Students' Feedback

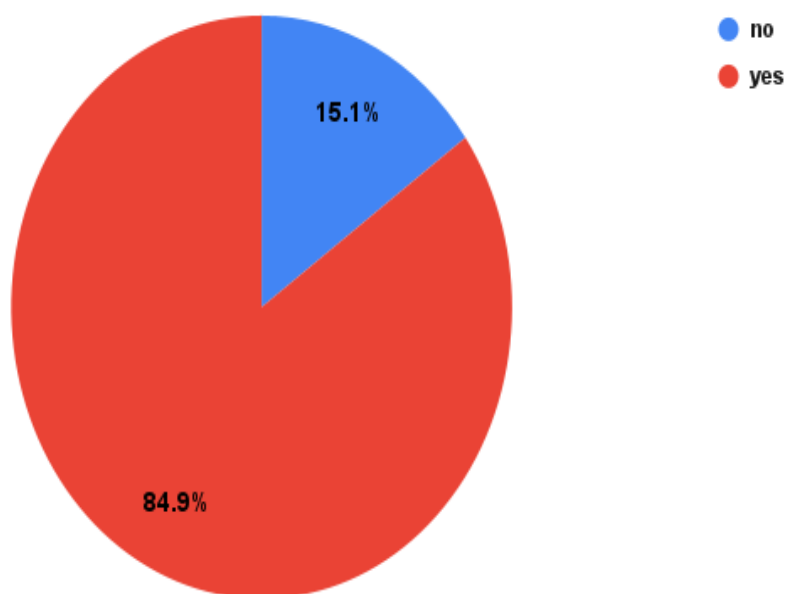
Count of 1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



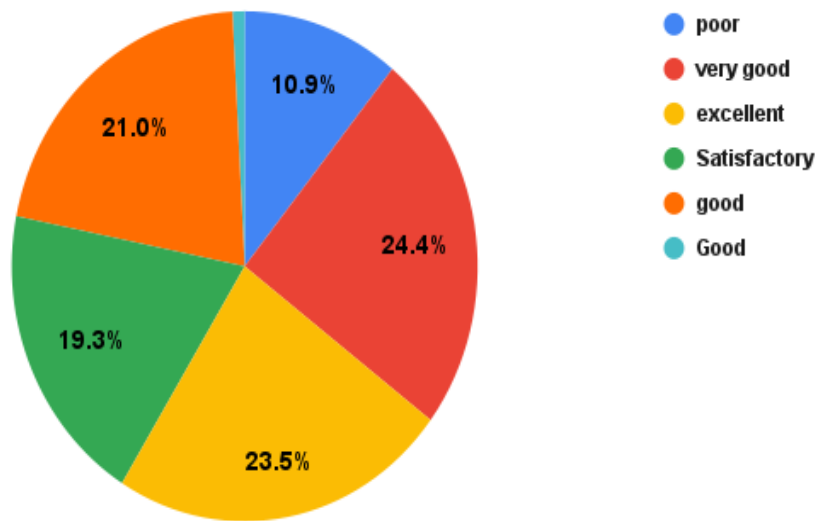
Count of 2.Student-teacher relationship



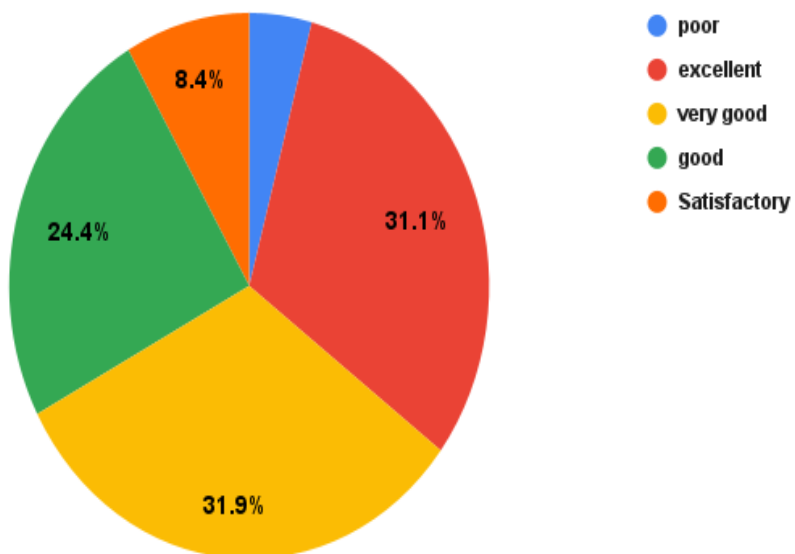
Count of 3. Was Syllabus completed on time?



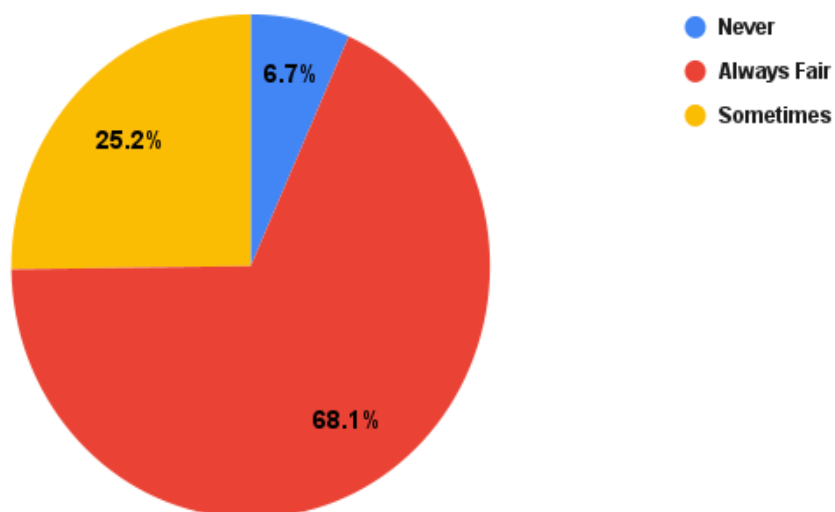
Count of 4. Availability of prescribed books/magazines/news papers



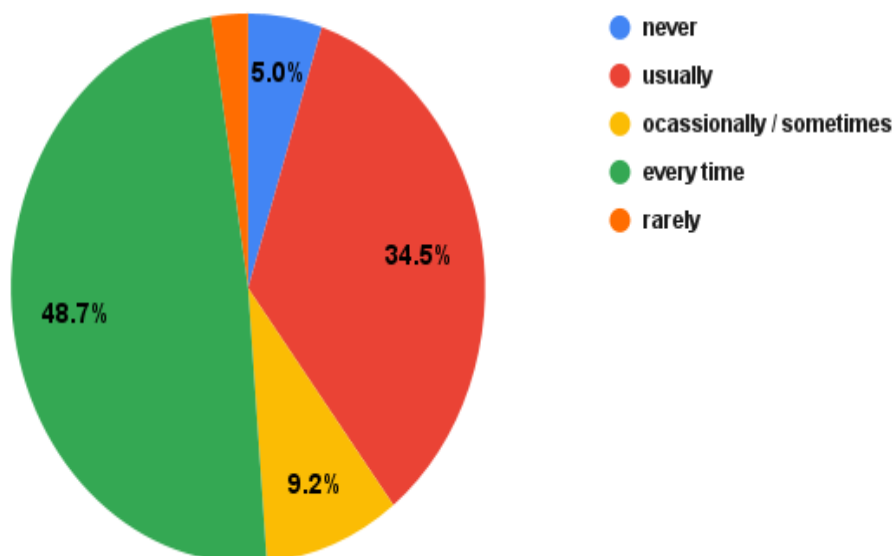
Count of 5. Functioning of NCC/NSS/YRC



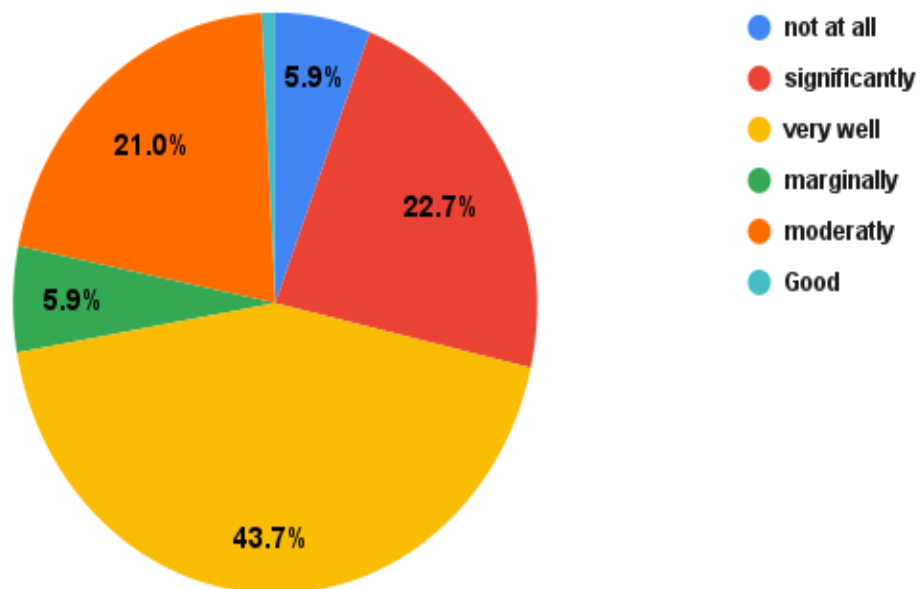
Count of 6. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers



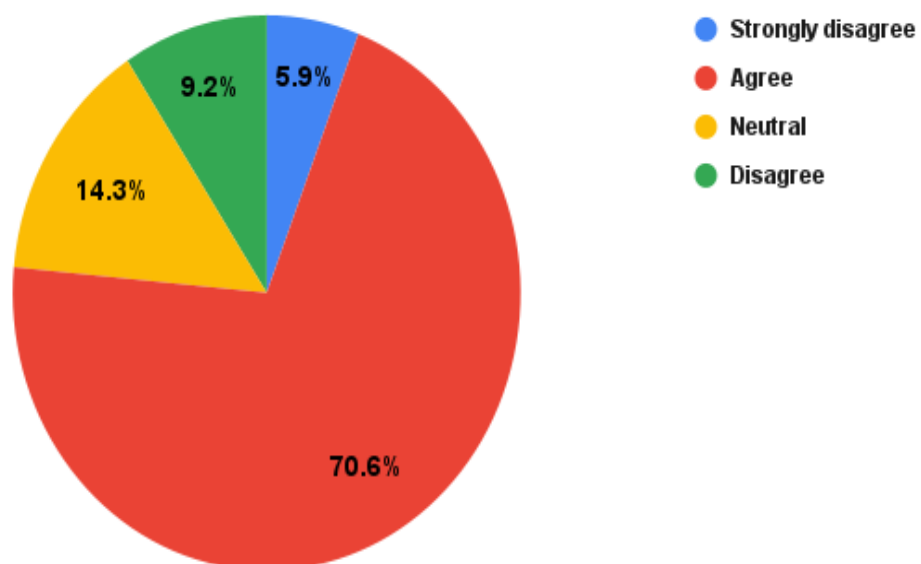
Count of 7. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



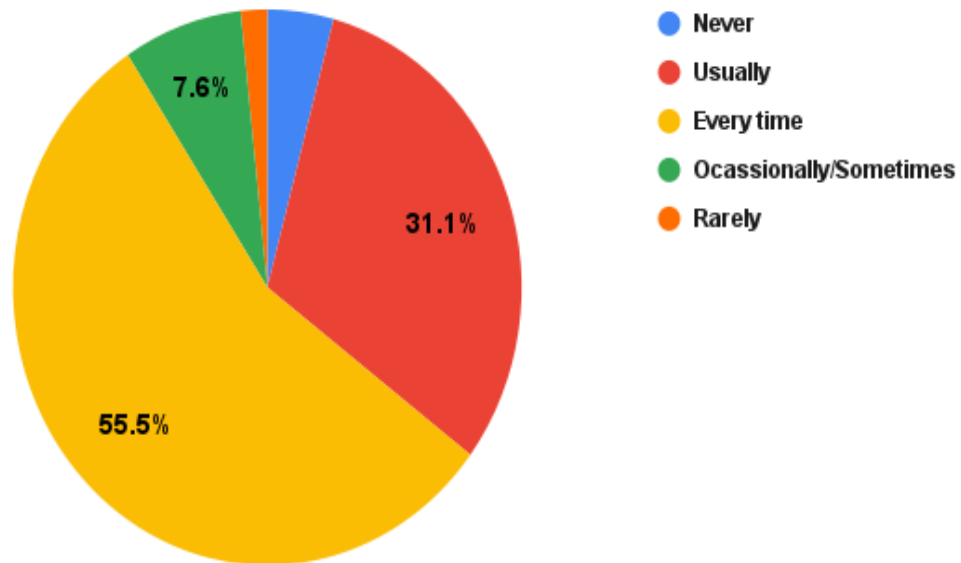
Count of 8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional



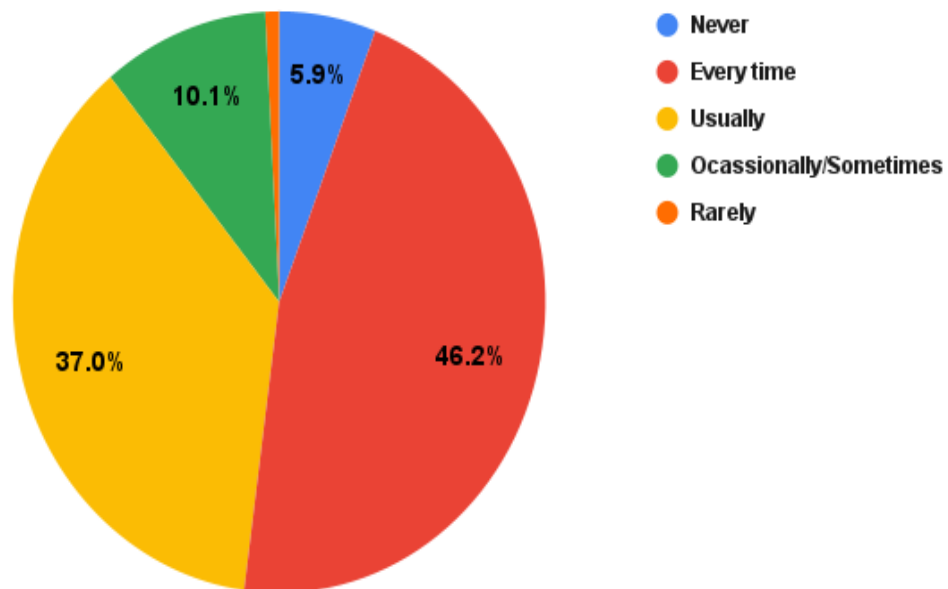
Count of 9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.



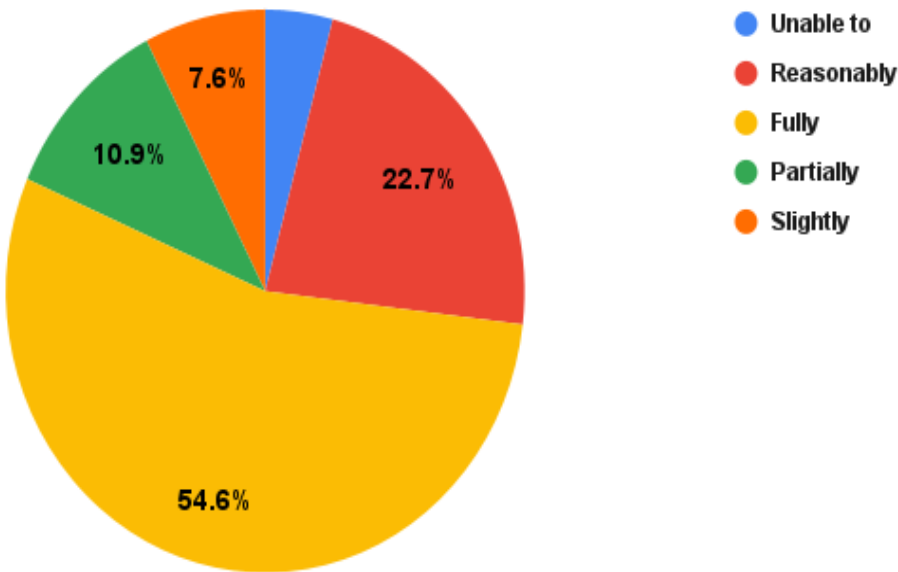
Count of 10. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



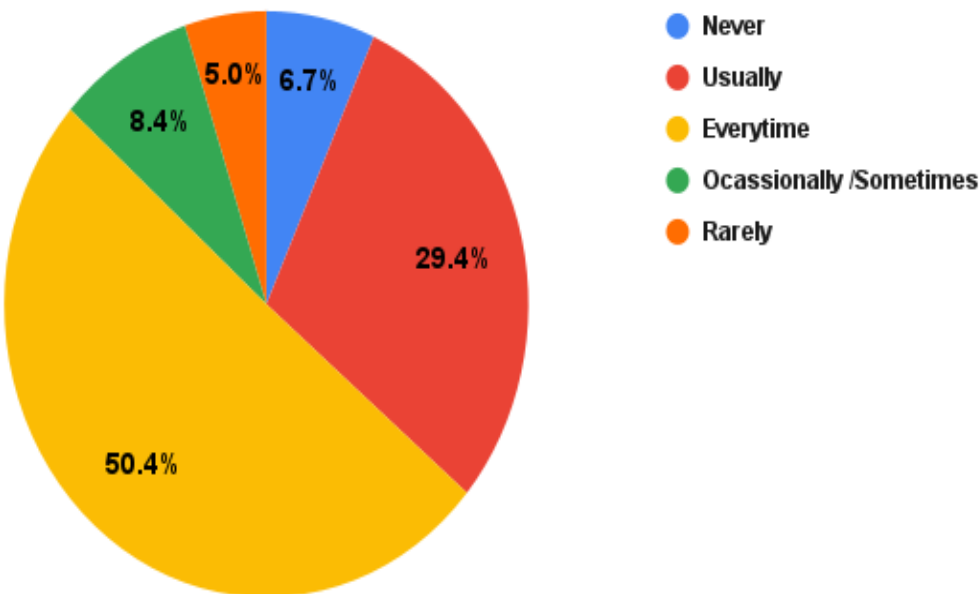
Count of 11. Consideration and solution of Grievances



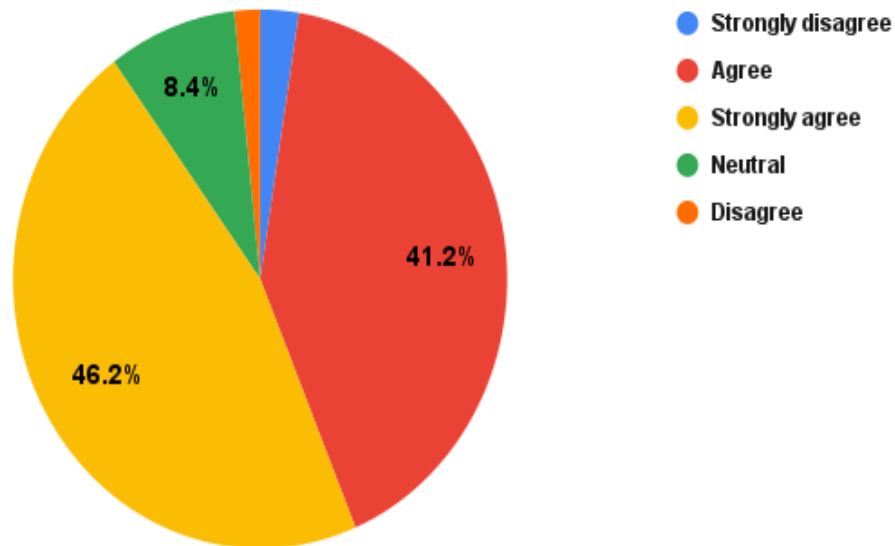
Count of 12. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.?



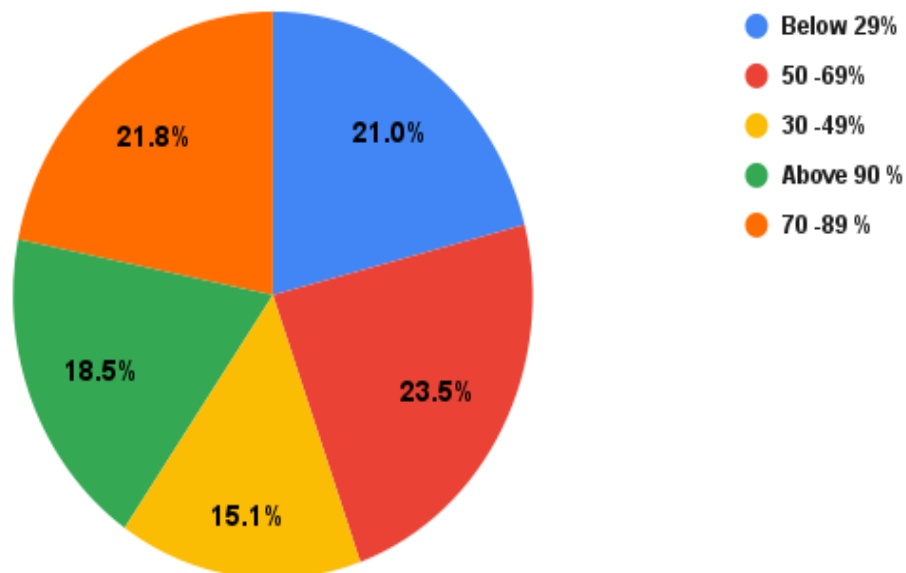
Count of 13. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.

Feedback Analysis Report

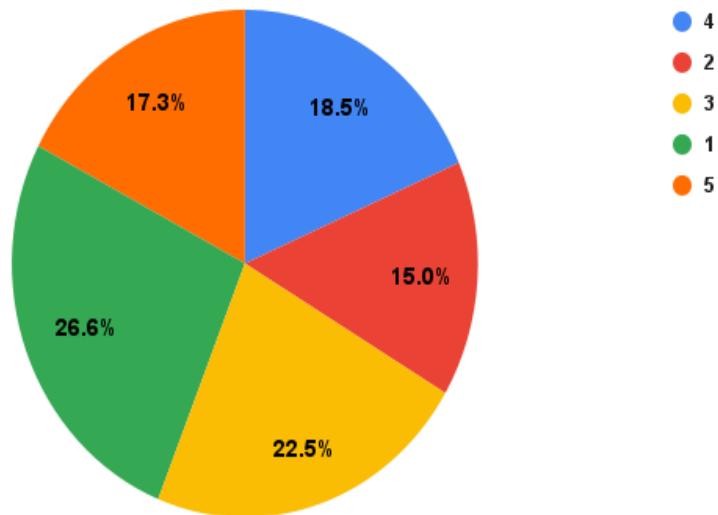
- The analysis of the students' feedback clearly depicts that they are well satisfied with the teaching learning process and completion of syllabus was on time.
- Most of the students are satisfied with the infrastructure facilities such as laboratories, conference/seminar hall, Eco-friendly campus etc.
- The students highly appreciated the functioning of NCC/NSS/Legal Literacy Cell/YRC etc.
- It is observed from the students' feedback that few of them expressed the need of digital learning process. They also expressed that proper drinking water should be arranged and infrastructure facilities especially washrooms should be improved.

After analyzing of this feedback, it is decided that in the next session, the digital learning process will be implemented and infrastructure facilities will be improved.

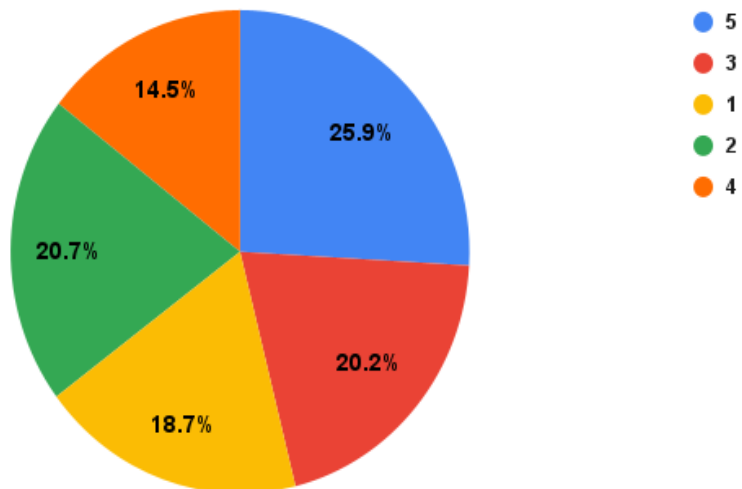
Alumni Feedback

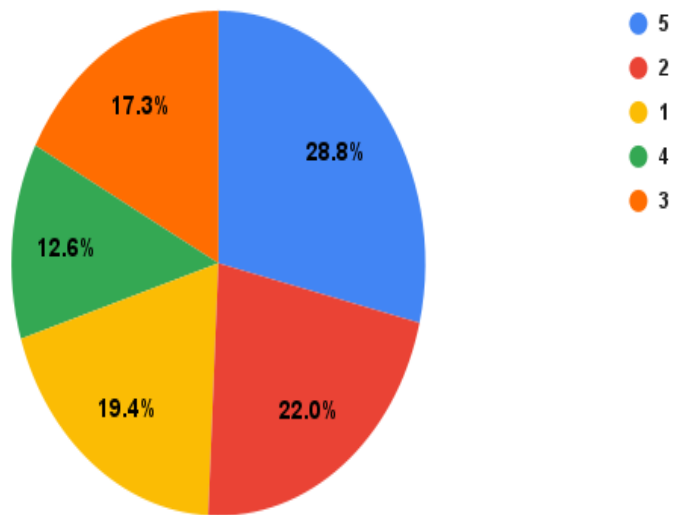
1) Student Teacher Relationship



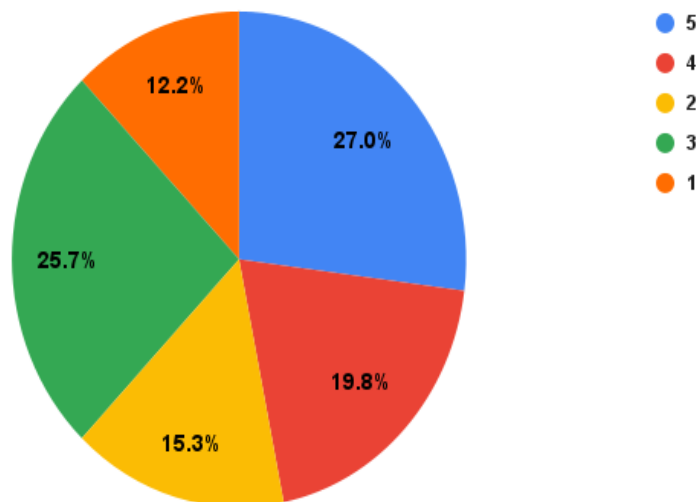
2) Quality of Academic Resources namely Teachers, Study Material etc.



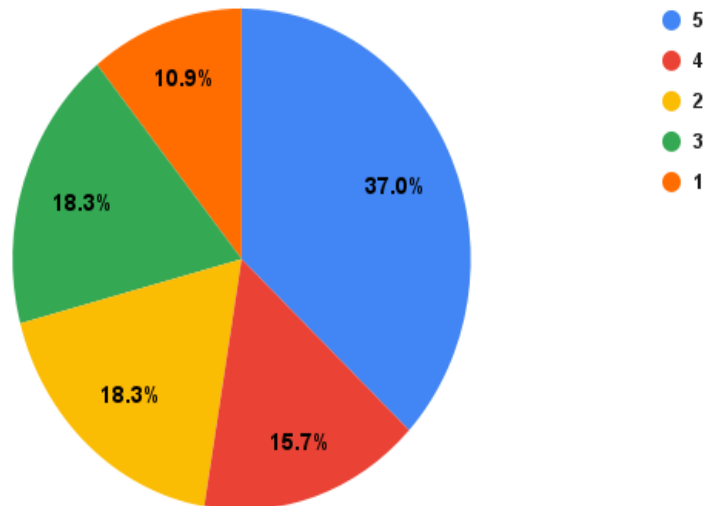

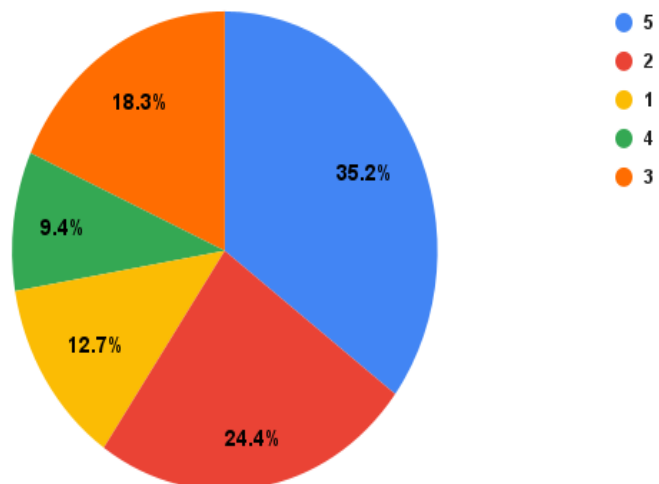

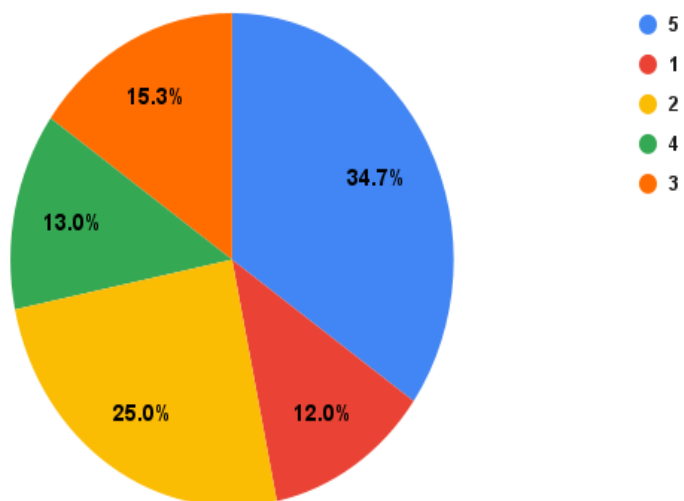

Feedback Analysis Report

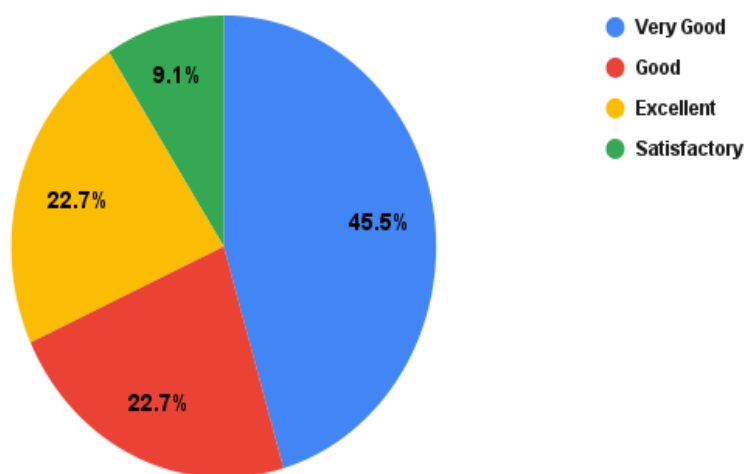
1. The alumni feedback analysis report reveals that majority of the alumni are happy with student teacher relationship and proud to be a part of this institution and they agreed that they would recommend their friends and relatives to enroll in this institution.

After analysis of this feedback, it is decided that in the next session, the modern teaching aids will be provided to the students and placement activities will be increased to enhance their skills.

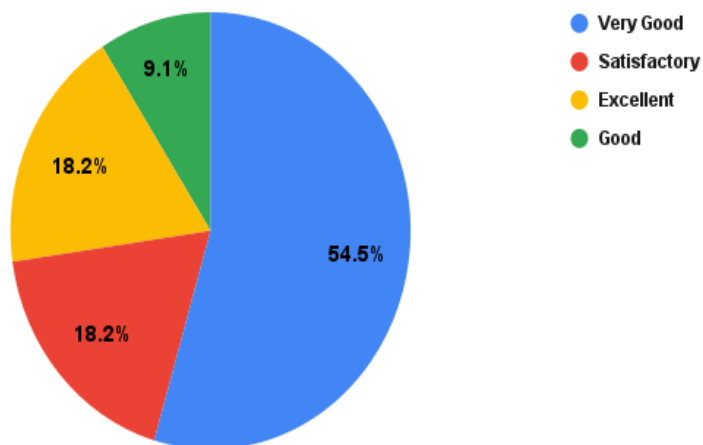
Teachers' Feedback

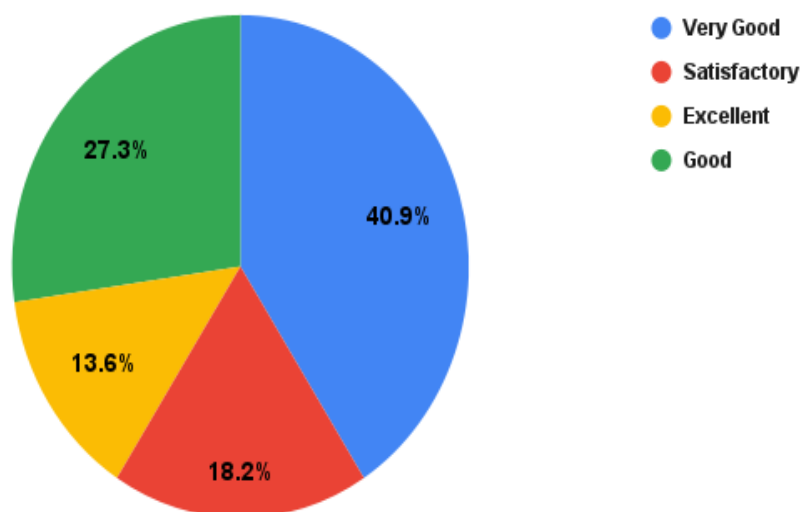
Count of 1. Infrastructural facilities such as Staff room, Class rooms, Reading room



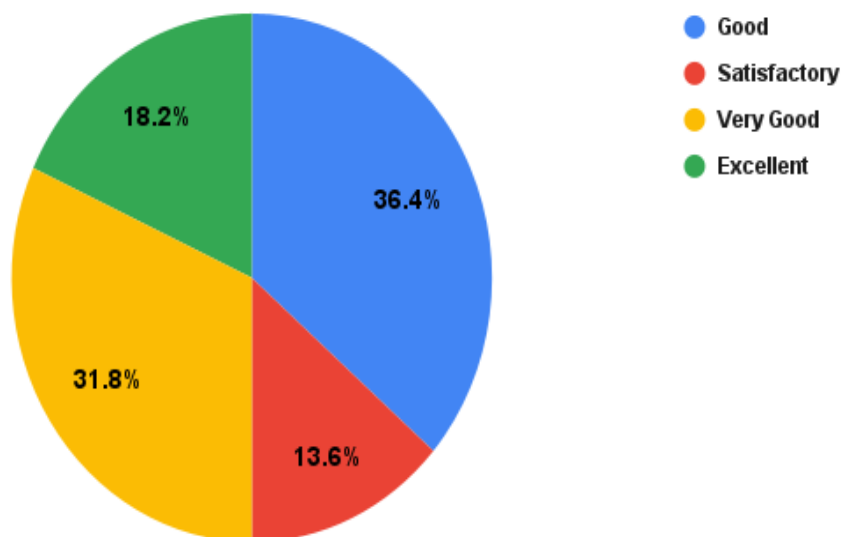
Count of 2. No. of prescribed books & reference books available in the library



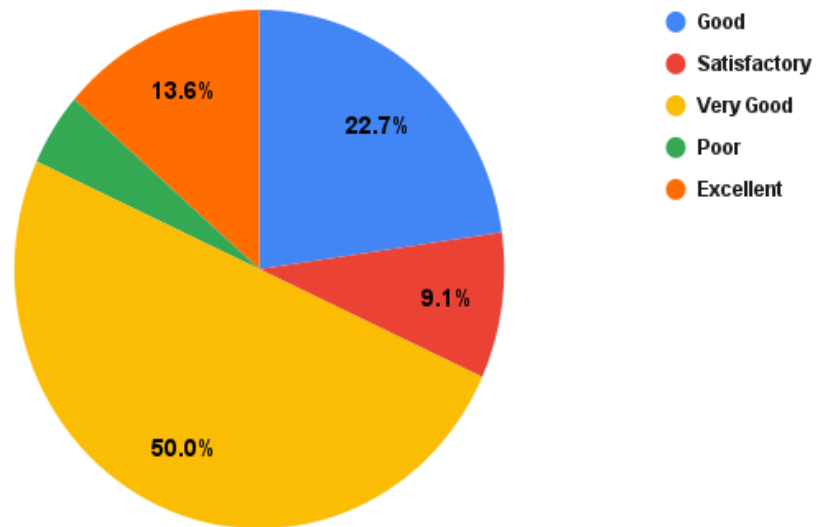
Count of 3. The environment in the College is conducive to teaching & research



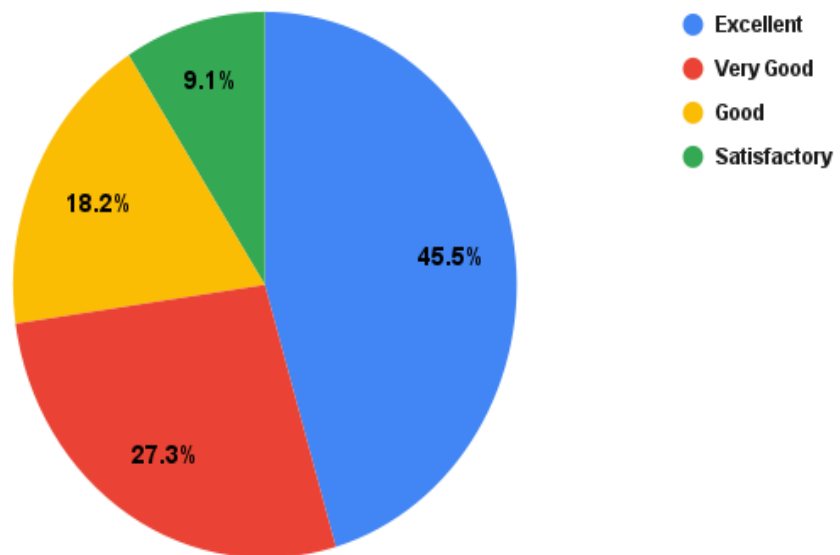
Count of 4. Institution provides adequate support to faculty member for upgrading their skills & qualifications



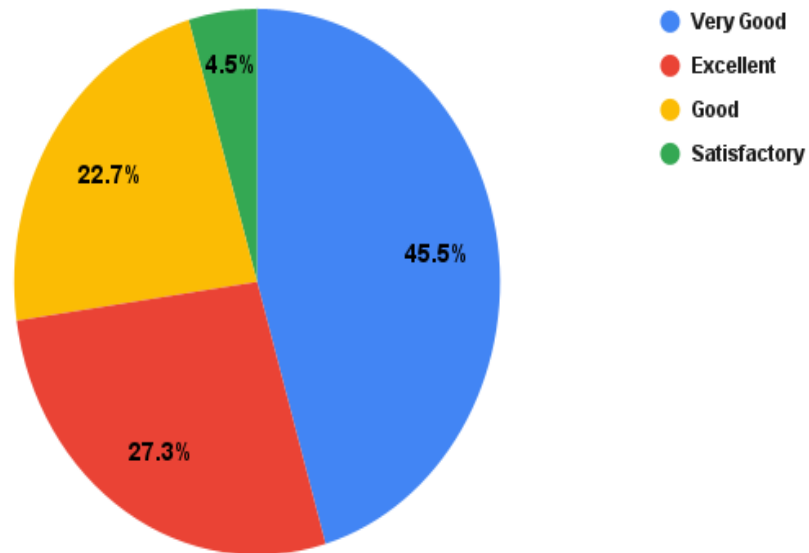
Count of 5. Parking facility for staff



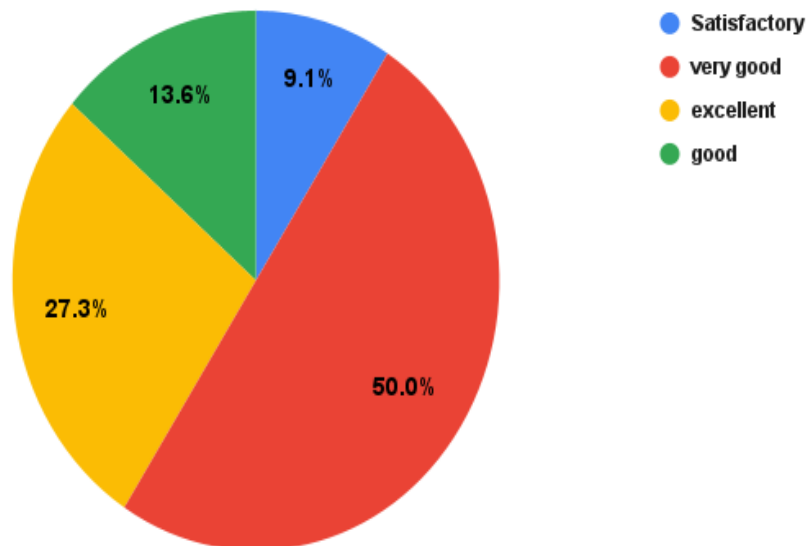
Count of 6. Co-operation among all faculty members



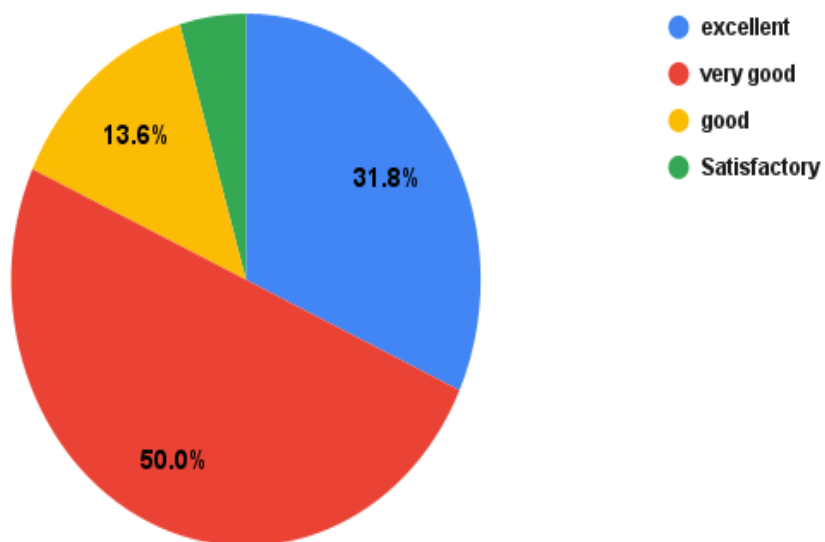
Count of 7. Relation between Teaching and Non-Teaching staff
