ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

In the year 1946, Vaish College, Rohtak was established under the umbrella of Vaish Education Society, Rohtak to impart meaningful education. After independence and due to partition of the country students from Hailey College of Commerce, Lahore joined the college for commerce education. During the courses of evolution the college has expanded itself into multi-faculty institution offering under graduate as well as post graduate courses in Arts, Science and Commerce. Initially the college was affiliated to Punjab University, then to Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra. After the establishment of MDU in 1976, the college is affiliated to Maharishi Dayanand University, Rohtak. It is also recognized by UGC, New Delhi under section 2(f) & 12(b) and is receiving development assistance under different schemes. The college is now a Post Graduate college with PG course in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and Commerce. The College is an aided College getting regular Aid from Govt. of Haryana. To the curricula, 04 UG, 01 Hons., and 04 PG programmes are being offered. The governance of the college is wholly democratic and inclusive, involving all the stakeholders in decision-makings for quality improvements and sustenance in all the spheres of college education. The Governing Body of the College is the highest decision making body comprising President, Vice-President, General Secretary and Treasurer (all duly elected through electoral process for a period of three years), the college Principal (Ex-Officio Secretary), eleven nominated members from Vaish Education Society, two teachers' representatives, and one non-teaching representative. The governing body takes final decisions on all key issues and also reviews the minutes of meetings of the IQAC.

For Quality sustenance and enhancement measures, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college takes regular feedback from the stakeholders viz., students, parents, alumni, employers etc. An Academic Calendar having complete schedule is available to all and uploaded on the college website. Beyond classroom curriculum delivery, the learning and development of the students is promoted through various field activities viz. Sports, Yoga, extracurricular, co-curricular, and outreach activities. The various cells of the college organizes a variety of programmes to involve the students in social initiatives relevant to Gender Sensitization, Environment Consciousness, Eco-friendly attitude, Energy conservation and Human Values and Professional Ethics. The Birth Anniversaries of freedom fighters and great personalities are celebrated so that students imbibe their traits, values and views.

 - vi. College will get registered to Academic bank Credits (ABC) platform developed by National-e-Governance Division Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology so that credits earned by students through various courses as per University format would get deposited and these credits will be used to give appropriate certification to students from time to time.
 - vii. To start some certificate courses for the students in the college to improve their Job-oriented skills. Students can pursue along with undergraduate courses.

- viii. Introduction of additional courses like Skill Development /Foreign Languages, e-learning etc
- ix. Adoption of Smart Classrooms in the institute for the innovative teaching practices.
- x. Regular feedback will be taken from the stakeholders' viz., students, parents, alumni, employers and academic peers. It will be analyzed and action is taken accordingly.
- xi. To motivate & encourage students to join MOOCs courses and enroll on Swayam platform.

2. Teaching, Learning and Evaluation: In order to make the teaching, learning and evaluation effective and efficient, following steps are proposed to be undertaken:

- i. To built ICT based Learning Management System (LMS) and e-resources which the students access using their separate login ID and Password.
- ii. To build some new Smart Class rooms to assist the faculty in ICT enabled teaching.
- iii. Summer training as per curriculum requirement will be provided.
- iv. College will organize many FDPs and workshops for the faculty at regular intervals so that Faculty members will be encouraged to come out with innovative and novel methods of teaching.
- v. Teachers will be encouraged for use of online Teaching and Learning resources.
- vi. The college has planned to organize training programs related to the use of ICT, research and innovation, field-based teaching methods, IPR, advanced instrumentation, examination system, curricula development, etc.
- vii. Training programs for inclusive education.

3. Internship, MoUs & Collaborations:

- i. Internship with industries will be incorporated in the curriculum of degree programmes to bridge the gap between industry and academia.
- ii. MoUs and Collaborations with established Universities/Institutes to promote academic excellence.
- iii. To have more MoUs with premier institutions and take up collaborative research projects.
